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### PERFORMANCE NOTES

- Breath marks are suggestions only
- The songs can be performed individually or as a set, but if they are as a set they should be in the order as presented in the score
- The *mmm* sound is a resonant humming sound, perhaps with a slightly open mouth if necessary, to create a fuller sound.
- The *Ab* sound is a generic 'A' sound such as one from the southern counties of England may say when pronouncing the word 'after'
- The *Ooo* sound could be a more exaggerated version of that sound found in the word 'smooth'
