#### PERFORMANCE NOTES

Accidentals apply throughout the bar.

A sense of freedom should be apparent throughout the piece.

In concert performances the Priest voice may be taken by any suitable male voice, but not the same baritone as in the solo sections.

The *mmm* sound is a resonant humming sound, perhaps with a slightly open mouth if necessary to create a fuller sound.

Breath marks are suggestions only.

The hummed chords are to be held until the end of each chant – the choir may breath independently to continue the chord.

#### PROGRAMME NOTE


My setting of the *Matin Responsory* aims to give a contemporary update to the version attributed to Palestrina (with a little help from David Willcocks) that is performed at King's College, Cambridge (and elsewhere) every year. It follows the same responsory from as the Palestrina with newly harmonised choral sections that follow the shape of the original, but provide a different harmonic and emotional palette. As with much of my work, this is more of a 're-encountering' of the text, form and feel of the responsory than a wholly new take on the genre.
